


The Magic Pencil


THE SCARY BUNGALOW




School Magazine

It was originally subtitled 'A Magazine of Literature for Our Boy and Girls'. School Magazine was Established during World War 1, the Magazine was intended to expand the range of reading material available to New South Wales primary school students. Stephen Henry Smith was the magazine's first editor, followed by Doris Chadwick, who held the position of editor from 1922 to 1959. This school has the oldest magazine in Australia and the longest running literary

magazine for children in the world. The magazine has thrived as a showpiece of original writing for children by children from authors in Australia, New Zealand, the US, India, the UK, and a number of Asian, Pacific and African nations. The magazine has played and continues to play a role in fostering new

talents in writing for children. To foster literacy skills, the School Magazine also publishes teaching units, which offers lesson plans and worksheets to assist teachers in maximising the use of the literary material for their students. 



<u>Moon Halo</u>

The moon's halo or lunar halo is an optical illusion that causes a large bright ring to surround the moon. This striking and often beautiful halo around the moon is caused by the refraction of moonlight from ice crystals in the upper atmosphere. Halo moons are associated with high cirrus clouds, which are composed of fine ice crystals. A halo is a ring or light that forms around the moon as light refracts off ice crystals present in a thin veil of cirrus clouds. The halo is usually seen as a bright white-ring although sometimes it can have colour.



This picture was clicked by me when the Moon Halo was visible on 24th November 2023 at 10:00PM.

In folklore, a ring around the moon forecasts bad weather on the way. Moon rings or halos are not extremely rare. The halo is fairly common especially as the weather gets cold. Rings around the moon are caused when sunlight passes through thin clouds of ice crystals high in earth's atmosphere. As moonlight passes through ice crystals, it bends in a sway similar to light passing through a lens. The shape of ice crystals causes the moonlight to be focussed into a ring.

On November 24th 2023, night around 10:00PM, there was an interesting sight in the sky as a big halo appeared around the moon. I observed moon halo from my terrace and it was a wonderful experience.




Bluey - My Pet



SACHIN! The Master! Blaster!

Sachin Ramesh Tendulkar (born on 24 April 1973) is an Indian former cricketer who captained the Indian national team. He is widely regarded as one of the greatest batsmen in the history of cricket. Hailed as the world's all-time highest run scorer in both ODI and Test Cricket with more than 18,000 and 15,000 runs, respectively. Tendulkar was a part of Indian team that was one of the jointwinners of 2002 ICC Champion's Trophy. Later in his career, Tendulkar was part of the Indian team that won the 2011 Cricket World Cup. He is the one who scored the most hundreds (100) in the history of international cricket. He started his career in 1989 and retired in 2013. Tendulkar has received several awards from the government of India: The Arjuna Award (1994), The Khel Ratna Award (1997), The Padma Shri (1998), and Padma Vibhushan (2008). After Sachin played his last international match in November 2013 against Pakistan, The Prime Minister announced the decision to award him the Bharat Ratna. He is the youngest person to receive this award. He scored a ton of runs and lead India to victory in most of the matches by combining with Saurav Ganguly and Rahul Dravid. He promoted Mumbai Indians in IPL. He has a son named Arjun Tendulkar, currently playing for Mumbai Indians. Sachin was also a part-time spin bowler who took 200+ wickets in international cricket. So literally, Sachin Ramesh Tendulkar is one of the greatest Indians in history.






My Trip on a Houseboat.

1) What are the different types of ships?

Ans) There are many types of ships, few of which are .

- a) Tanker ships These ships carry liquid cargoes like oil, chemicals and gases in liquid form.
- b) Bulk carriers These ships carry solid cargoes like food grains, steel, mineral ore etc.
- c) Cruise ships These ships carry people.
- d) Cattle carrier These ships carry live animals like sheep, goat, camel, etc.
- e) Car/Truck carrier These ships carry different types of vehicles like cars, trucks etc.
 - 2) Which is the type of ship you work on?

Ans) I sail on oil and chemical tanker ships which carry refined petroleum products and different kinds of chemicals in liquid form.

3) What do you do on ships?

Ans) I sail as Chief Engineer, who is responsible for all the technical aspects related to the smooth operation of the ship.

4) Which is the biggest ship ever built?

Ans) The M.T.Seawise Giant was the largest ship ever built. It could carry around 3 lakh tonnes of crude oil. It is currently out of service.



5) How many engines does a ship have?

Ans) Most of the ships have one or two main engines which are used to propel the ship and another three to four auxiliary engines which are used for providing the necessary electrical power for the ship.

6) From where do you get food and water on ships?

Ans) The provisions are loaded and stored on ships. The galley staff use these provisions to prepare and serve food for all on the ship.

The fresh water required is produced and stored on ships from sea water, by use of different processes like distillation, reverse osmosis, etc.

7) How ships avoid cyclones and rough weather on the seas?

Ans) The ships use weather forecasts to fix the route for a particular voyage. It is sometimes not completely possible to avoid the rough seas. The ships are designed and built considering all these factors which effect it.

8) Which all places in the world have you been to on a ship?


Ans) I have been to all the continents in the world except Antarctica.






MARRIAGE OR BUSINESS...?
